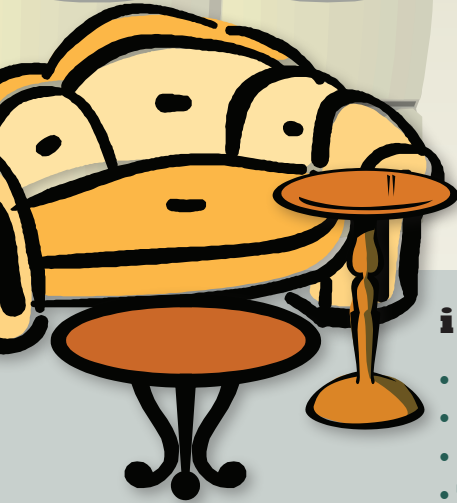
Large Item Recirculation Day "Introductory Event"
